



Rainier Golf and Country Club ~ Dress Code ~

Appropriate golf attire is required at all times for Members and their guests on the Golf Course, in the Clubhouse and all Practice Facilities. It is the Member's responsibility to inform his or her guest of the dress code requirements. The Pro Shop and Clubhouse staff has been directed to inform any Member or Guest not in compliance with the dress code.

Proper Attire - Ladies and Female Juniors:

- Appropriate dress for women shall include slacks, skirts and shorts. Skirts and shorts must not be shorter than 4" above the knee. All clothing must be clean and presentable.
- Tailored blouses or golf shirts, if sleeveless, must have a collar.
- All hats, caps and visors must be worn with the bill facing the front and removed before entering Main Clubhouse, lounge or dining facilities.
(see exception under Rule #33 – A & B of House Rules)
- All footwear must be approved for wear on golf course. Rainier is a year round soft spike facility. Golfers under 11 years may wear tennis shoes for golf. Spikes are not allowed in Clubhouse except Golf Shop, Locker Rooms and Lounges. No bare or stocking feet allowed unless in Pool or Locker Room areas.

Proper Attire - Gentleman and Male Juniors:

- Appropriate dress for men shall include slacks and shorts. All shorts must not be shorter than 4" above the knee. All clothing must be clean and presentable.
- All shirts must have a collar (traditional or mock), Golf/Polo shirts must be tucked in at all times. Button down/camp style shirts may be worn un-tucked.
- All hats, caps and visors must be worn with the bill facing the front and removed before entering Main Clubhouse, lounge or dining facilities.
(see exception under Rule #33 – A & B of House Rules)
- All footwear must be approved for wear on golf course. Rainier is a year round soft spike facility. Golfers under 11 years may wear tennis shoes for golf. Spikes are not allowed in Clubhouse except Golf Shop, Locker Rooms and Lounges. No bare or stocking feet allowed unless in Pool or Locker Room areas.

The following attire is not acceptable within Clubhouse, Golf Course or Practice Areas:
Blue jeans or denim, athletic shorts, cut-offs, swim suits, halter tops, tank tops, spandex, bare midriff garments, sweat suits of style commonly used for jogging or gym.

Club appropriate denim is acceptable in the following areas on FRIDAYS ONLY:
Dining Room, Atrium, Main Lounge, Men's Lounge, All Locker Rooms, Patio and Exercise Room. Acceptable denim does not include denim with holes, frayed material, denim shorts, work-type denim pants or bibs, painter pants or those denim pants that are extremely low cut. Denim will not be allowed on the Golf Course, Driving Range, Short Game, Practice Area, Practice Putting Greens or Golf Shop.
